

The degree requirements for the Emergency and Disaster Management and Emergency Health Leadership tracks include approved elective courses. These pathways offer three approved options based on the track and pathway you select to pursue.

Emergency and Disaster Management Track

Students have three pathways to choose from to complete 27 elective credits: approved electives, minor(s), or certificate. Students may combine pathways to achieve the required 27 credits. Regardless of pathway selected, students must complete at least 9 credits at the 300- or 400-level.

Emergency Health Leadership Track

Students in the Emergency Health Leadership Track must complete 14 credits of electives, including at least 9 credits at the 300- or 400-level from the list of approved electives.
